Grounds for objection

You can object to a decision or an assessment. Select the reason for objecting relevant to your situation.

Objection to a decision

Reason for objecting to a decision (section 90(1) of the Child Support Act 1991). You may tick more than one.

- about the proportion of care established for a child

- not to accept a request to end a child support formula assessment, or to overturn a previous decision to accept a request to end a child support formula assessment

- to issue an assessment because I estimated but I have not filed my tax return
- to charge a penalty
- to accept a voluntary agreement

- to accept or decline a change to a voluntary agreement
- about the date a change of circumstances occurred

- to stop or not stop child support payments while I am waiting for an administrative review decision
- to decline to refund an overpayment because I still have child support to pay.

Objection to an assessment

Reason for objecting to an assessment (section 91(1) of the Child Support Act 1991). You may tick more than one.

Note: When you object to a reassessment your objection can only be accepted in relation to the change.

Reasons for objecting

You need to explain why you are objecting. It is important you give us all the information and supporting evidence to help us fully consider your objection. If you use extra sheets of paper, write your name and IRD number at the top of each page and attach to this form.

Late objection

If your objection is late (more than 28 days from the date shown on the decision or letter), please explain why. We cannot consider a late objection unless a reason for its lateness is given.
