Thank you for your request made under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), which was partially transferred to Inland Revenue on 27 November 2024 from the office of the Minister of Revenue. You requested the following:

Data on the departmental OIA requests that Inland Revenue provided to the Minister of Revenue's office for the period 15 May 2024 – 15 November 2024.

Information being released

Inland Revenue sent 102 departmental Official Information Act requests to the Minister of Revenue's office for noting or consultation between 15 May 2024 to 15 November 2024.

Two of these OIA requests were sent to the requestor one day late. The response time for 10 requests was either fully or partially extended as follows:

- One request was extended by 27 working days,
- One request was extended by 24 working days,
- Two requests were extended by 20 working days,
- Five requests were extended by 15 working days, and
- One request was extended by 10 working days.

Right of review

If you disagree with my decision on your OIA request, you can ask an Inland Revenue review officer to review my decision. To ask for an internal review, please email the Commissioner of Inland Revenue at: commissionerscorrespondence@ird.govt.nz.

If you choose to have an internal review, you can still ask the Ombudsman for a review.
