Thank you for your request made under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), received on 31 January 2025. You requested the following:

Whether the Inland Revenue Department rents or sublets accommodation to any employees, or provides accommodation to any employees as an entitlement through their employment contract. This includes accommodation that is owned or leased by the Inland Revenue Department, and refers to long-term as well as short-term accommodation.

Inland Revenue does not rent or sublet accommodation to employees. Occasionally, if accommodation hasn't been prepaid, employees may receive contributions toward or reimbursements for agreed costs incurred due to work-related travel, such as business trips or relocations.

Publishing of OIA response

We intend to publish our response to your request on Inland Revenue's website (ird.govt.nz) as this information may be of interest to other members of the public. This letter, with your personal details removed, may be published in its entirety. Publishing responses increases the availability of information to the public and is consistent with the OIA's purpose of enabling more effective participation in the making and administration of laws and policies and promoting the accountability of officials.
