

Dear

Thank you for your request made under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), received on 14 April 2022. You requested "any analysis or advice that the IRD has prepared since January 2020 on the effective marginal tax rates that beneficiaries are facing."

On 14 April 2022, you clarified "analysis or advice" is for any reports, briefing notes, aide memoires, and cabinet papers.

I understand you sent a similar OIA request to the Ministry of Social Development (MSD), for any reports, briefing notes, aide memoires, and cabinet papers they prepared since January 2020.

Inland Revenue and the MSD have prepared joint reports that included effective marginal tax rates that beneficiaries are facing. The Minister of Social Development's OIA response will acknowledge the joint reports.

The only item within scope of your request which won't be acknowledged in MSD's response is the *Regulatory Impact Statement: April 2022 Working for Families changes*.
